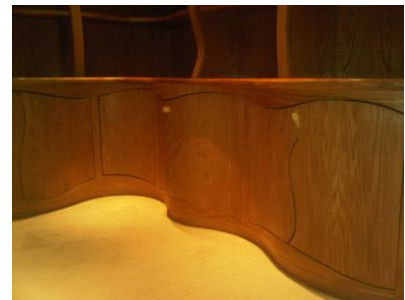
Introduction:

The following case study outlines the thoroughly enjoyable and at times challenging process we went through to create a stunning piece of furniture for our clients. This was one of the most unique and challenging projects under taken by Bespoke Joinery but it was also one of the most enjoyable. The project itself had been turned down by a number of other joinery companies before it came to us.

Initial Design Brief:

Our basic design brief was inspired by the Spanish artist Gaudi. This meant there were to be a minimal amount of straight lines making this unit unique in every way. With no 2 curves being the same this created another problem as every unit and shelf had to be individually set out and made to the clients specifications. And all of this was to be made with an oak finish.

At this stage we worked closely with our client to ensure each and every curve was made to there satisfaction from the shelves to the doors and drawer fronts. The doors and drawer fronts posed the biggest challenge of all as they not only curved across the face with the shape of the units but they also curved along the edges as well in order to create an interlocking jigsaw effect
